Position: Lifeguard - Seasonal, from June through Labor Day

Open positions: 4

Salary: \$13.00 per hours

Work Hours - 3 time slots daily: 9-5, 10-6, 11-7, Schedules are determined by management with set says off

Availability: Candidates must be available 7 days a week.

Requirements: Aquatic venue certification issued by an authorized certifying agency or individual, including Lifeguard, first aid, CPR and AED.

Equipment: All necessary and required equipment needed to perform the job will be supplied by RIMYF. T-shirts will also be supplied.

Experience: Preferred but not required

Application period: Until all positions are filled

Duties and responsibilities

- Monitors and supervises aquatic activities
- Ensure that all individuals taking part in these activities adhere to the rules to prevent injuries and other accidents
- Responds to any emergencies in a timely manner, provide first aid and other basic injury treatment as necessary (Within qualifications)
- Notify management of any/all injuries or first aid matters in a timely fashion
- Call emergency services when necessary
- Open pool each day and close it at the end of the day, depending on shift assignment
- Daily monitoring, testing and recording of pool water quality
- Monitoring pool patrons and activity closely, enforcing pool rules and guidelines
- Discourage any unsafe activities, correct any violations of pool rules and guidelines, identify and correct any safety hazards
- Direct swimmers out of the pool if an unsafe situation arises:
 1. Hazardous or dangerous items in the pool
 2. Biohazard materials in the pool
 3. Unresponsive swimmer
 4. Approach of dangerous weather conditions
- Maintain a safe environment within the confines of the pool
- Provide assistance to patron when appropriate or asked

- Test swimmers for their swimming proficiency in order to swim in deep end of the pool
- Monitor those who are using swimming assistance devices for proper use
- Any other duties and responsibilities assigned by management

Qualified candidates will:

- Have strong communication and interpersonal skills since they will be interacting with guests on a continual basis
- Be able to react and respond to emergency situations without hesitation
- Be able to diffuse potentially volatile situations
- Work cohesively with other lifeguards and staff
- Become familiar with, understand and follow all the policies and procedures set forth by RIMYF
- Must understand, adhere to and abide by all policies and regulations regarding aquatic venues issued by the R.I. Department of Health
- Maintain all necessary certifications and qualifications in order to remain in the employ of RIMYF as a lifeguard
